- During each session, there will ALWAYS be a chase boat with an instructor.

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

Q. Who can I contact about Sailing School?

Q. If it is raining, will lessons still be taught?

A. Yes! We have many activities lined up for rainy days. (Knot tying, land drills, etc.)

Q. I am late. What do I do?

A. Chances are, if you are not more that fifteen or twenty minutes late, you may be able to make it onto water with the rest of the students. If you expect to be later than that, please contact instructor Katherine Killcreas at (251) 709-2915, and arrangements will be made for a chase boat to come get that student. Make sure to call BEFORE 9:30 or 3:00, we may be on the water by that time and not be able to reach our phone!

Q. My camper is sick. What do I do?

Q. I am going to be late picking up my child. What do I do?

2. Each student must know how to swim, and will be required to pass a swim test. During the test the student must swim 75 yards, tread water for one minute, and be able to put on a life jacket (while in the water.)
3. Students must be between the ages of 8 and 18
